Keld Lundgaard

Keld Lundgaard (25) is a scientist and entrepreneur, who has taken a big role in shaping the Danish entrepreneurial student ecosystem. This comes from his great interest in entrepreneurship, and a dedication to work hard for making changes happen where and when needed.

He is the founder of Gate to Create, the national student entrepreneurship organization of Denmark, where he served as managing director in the founding year 2010-2011. In this period the organization achieved an almost full coverage of Denmark with nine organizations at eight of the nine Danish universities. His current role in Gate to Create is to serve as the head of international relations. He has been a part of iCUE's history from the beginning as member of the founding team, and the role of advisory board member of iCUE is a natural extension of his current activities.

Besides the engagement in Gate to Create, Keld Lundgaard is a Ph.D. Student at CAMD (DTU), where he develops new exchange correlation functionals, for Density Functional Theory calculations, in a cross university collaboration between CAMD (DTU, DK) and SUNCAT (Stanford, USA). This work is enabling screening for new catalytic materials for industrial uses, which can lower the environmental impact of the modern world.

Previously, he has been engaging in entrepreneurship first hand, and founded and partnered the company Blue Power Technologies. A technology startup that was nationally recognized, as winner of the Danish Venture Cup's Clean tech Idea competition, and as receiver of Voss' industrial stipend. He is actively pursuing new opportunities.
